- 1. The right to have its case tried to a jury; and
- 2. The right not to make a statement or to testify against itself; and
- 3. The right to use compulsory process to summon witnesses to testify in its defense and its right to confront witnesses who testify against it; and
- 4. The right to be found not guilty unless the City proves its guilt beyond a reasonable doubt at trial.
